On October 7th and 8th, 2010 there will be a two day seminar held at the Palace Station Hotel/ Casino in Las Vegas, Nevada...This seminar, co-sponsored by the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and recognized by Nevada POST, is titled, 'The Pain Behind The Badge & The Bullet Proof Mind'. These two days of training will address PTSD (Post Traumatic Stress Disorder), Cumulative Stress, how to deal with police related stress, recognizing these issues, the type of help available and what that stress can do when untreated. Topics such as 'Perception Protection', 'The Progression of Stress', and 'Spousal Involvement', in addition to an entirely new meaning to the acronym S.I.P.D.E. are also addressed. Other topics discussed are 'survival after the battle and years to come' &' Psychological preparation for combat', 'Survivors Guilt', 'The Warrior Spirit' and 'Combat Preparation for your spouse'. This



training does for the police and military mind, and the mind and spirit of spouses, what body armor does for the torso.

Clarke Paris is a military veteran, has more than 25 years experience with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department and is a former 'Police Officer of the Year'. He is also the Creator/Producer of the award winning documentary film on police stress and suicide, 'The Pain Behind The Badge'. The Pain Behind The Badge received both the 'Honorable Mention Award and 'Best Documentary' at International Film Festivals. Clarke was involved in recovery for several agencies including Virginia Tech PD (after the 33 student massacre) and Lakewood PD (after 4 officers were murdered in a coffee shop) and has been honored by the International Police Association for his contribution to Law Enforcement. Retired LT. Colonel Dave Grossman was an Army Ranger and is a former West Point Psychology Professor and professor of military science at Arkansas State University. Now the director of Killology Research Group, he has testified before the U.S. Congress & U.S. Senate. He was involved in counseling, recovery, on court cases in the aftermath of the Jonesboro, Paducah, Springfield, and Littleton School Massacres. He has published several books and audio tapes to include 'On Killing', 'Stop Teaching Our Kids to Kill', and 'On Combat'.

Both presenters travel and present their seminars to thousands of police officers and military personnel each year, but for the first time ever, they will team up to present two of the most powerful days of training geared towards saving cops minds and ultimately their lives in one of the most powerful cities in the world....Las Vegas, Nevada
